It is currently held at the Summit Bechtel Reserve in West Virginia.

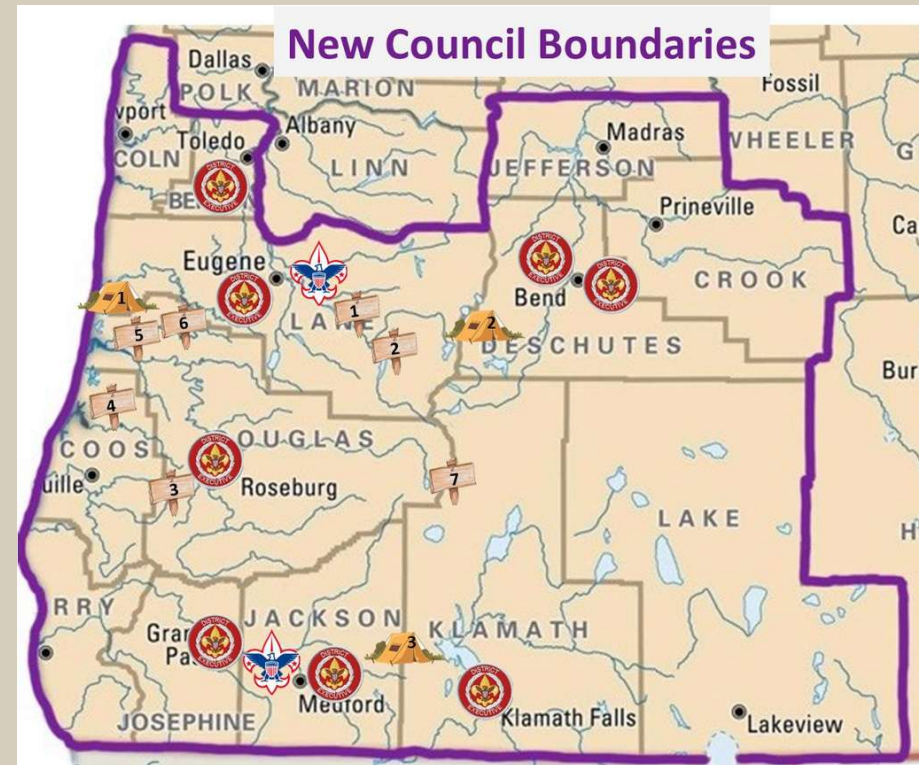
1 MALE TROOP: 36 YOUTH, 4 ADULTS

- Fundraising available and encouraged.



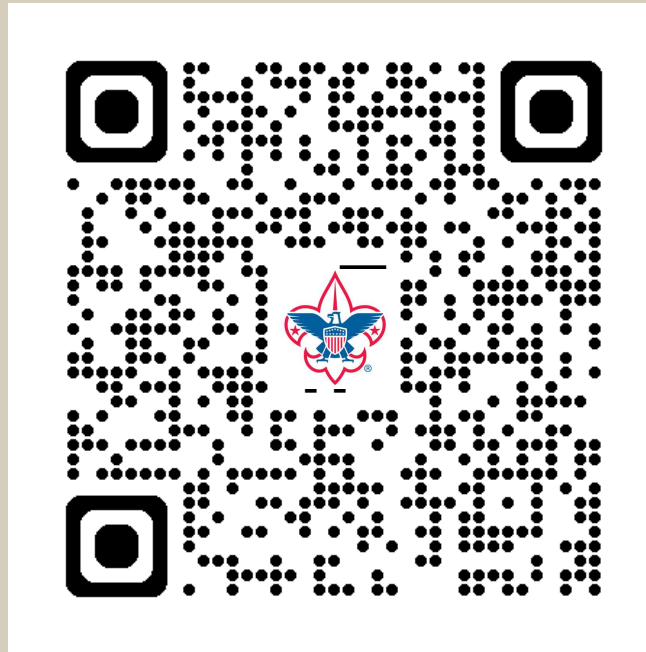
WHAT'S INCLUDED?

*Additional uniform items and patches may be purchased for trading. This is not included in the overall cost.



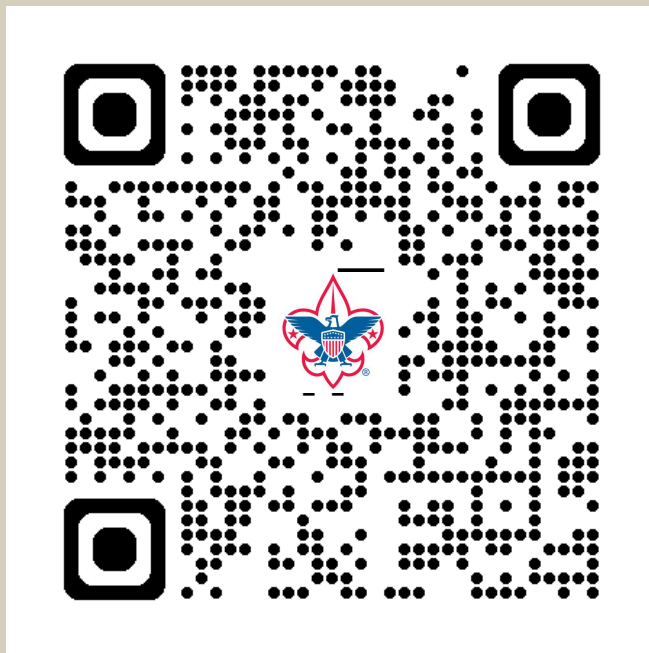
